ROLE OF AN ISO



The aim of International Service Organiser in the Inner Wheel movement is to foster 'Good Will' and build understanding among the members of Inner Wheel by helping the members throughout the world to get to know one another, for the ultimate realization of Inner Wheel objects and goals.

Guidelines for an ISO

- * The club must purchase or receive a soft copy of the Association Directory for the year 2021-22.
- * To form the link clubs within India (refer the Association Directory)
- * To form foreign link clubs

 (go to IIW Website i.e. https://www.internationalinnerwheel.org/clubs)

Foster Friendship

- * To promote and facilitate friendship at various levels of Inner Wheel within the District and Outside the District at National and International Level via letters & email.
- * Exchange Flags and Gifts with other Club ISOs at various events held at Inter-District Level.
- * Welcome Inner Wheel members from other districts and if possible provide home hospitality.

Correspondence

- * Correspondence should be through letters and emails only and not on Social Media. ATTEND TO LETTERS & EMAILS PROMPTLY.
- * Exchange Greetings with foreign and Indian Clubs.
- Send copies of Club Bulletins, News Letters to corresponding Clubs by Email.

- * A 'Link Club' is considered when there is an exchange of at least 3 letters within our country and minimum one exchange of letter with a foreign country.
- * The Previous Years Link Club try to keep in touch. Please DON'T STOP COMMUNICATING
- * Out of the 27 Districts in the Association, one District has been assigned to you as a Link District. You can correspond with all the Clubs in that District. Continue the correspondence with all those who reply back.

Coordination

- * Should coordinate about Inter District Projects and keep the District ISO informed.
- * Keep your Club President's well informed about the correspondence, Gifts and Flags sent and received
- * Update your District ISO about the work done by you, so that she can print that in the District Souvenir and in her report.

Motivate

- * Inform, update and motivate all the members of the clubs to participate in :
- * Inter club and District ISO programs
- District Rally
- * Inter District ISO Meet
- * Multi District Meet and other incoming events and competitions.

Triennial Conference/IIW Convention/South Asia Rally

- * The clubs can make flags/gifts in good numbers to exchange it with Clubs of other Districts.
- * You can add some special feature of your City/Club on the flag.
- * Flags should have the Club and District name and preferably "India" too, especially when you use it for exchange in places outside India.
- * Size of the Flag should be 7"x10".
- * Material may be Satin, Rexene, Handmade Paper or Flex.

Every year our District conducts a **joint ISO event** which though initially was done individually by Clubs has now been consolidated into one program to save on costs and make it convenient for all members to attend. This is an event which every member of Inner Wheel District 323 looks forward to with great eagerness. This year I have planned a lot of activities which will keep our members enthused and which I am sure you will also have fun coordinating and putting together along with me.

Grand ISO Event in the month of September - Since Inner Wheel believes in unity and fellowship, the theme for this year's Mega Event is "Pangea - The Seven Continents". We will have groups of our clubs representing the 7 continents - Asia, Africa, Europe, Australia, North America, South America and Antarctica. 7 Clubs will be allotted one topic each and the time limit is 10 minutes per topic. So you can do a combined group presentation involving all the Clubs for 10 minutes. The presentation can include dance, music, skits, speeches, anything creative to showcase your talents.

2. **Visit to Sri Lakshmi Narayani Golden Temple, Vellore** - On 3rd November, we plan to visit Vellore. The City plus Clubs will be hosting us and IWC Vellore and IWC Vellore North are the lead host Clubs. We plan a visit to the temple, Sri Lakshmi Narayani Golden Temple. Interesting games and events will also be conducted.

- 3. Naari Shakti Event On the 10th of January, to commemorate International Inner Wheel Day we plan to organise a Women Entrepreneurship Networking Event. They are willing to be inspired by role models and gain from the experience of other women in the business sector, but, the roadblock for them today is non-availability of networks and mentors which limits their professional growth. With the help of this event, they can showcase their small businesses to all the members of Inner Wheel. Each participant gets allotted a fixed time to talk about their business on stage.
- 4. **2 day trip to Chettinad** A 2 day visit to Chettinad will be planned in the month of March. We will be covering the top tourist attractions, palaces and museums and indulging in the lip smacking Chettinad delicacies of the region .
